3. Recommendation on the nomination of a new Director General at Champlain Regional College

The Governing Board discussed its role in recommending the selection committee's candidate to the Board. Some members expressed concerns about the selection process and the limited amount of information provided. A few members felt they should have met the candidate, while others emphasized the need for more transparency to make an informed decision. However, some members expressed confidence that the selection committee had made a well-considered choice, noting that an external firm had also been hired for the process, which contributed to their confidence in the selection. It was also acknowledged that the process outlined in By-Law 3 was followed as specified.

One member highlighted the importance of this decision, given the current challenges the college is facing, and supported improving the selection process for the future. A concern was also raised about the inability to recruit a candidate from the English-speaking community, given the current context for anglophone CEGEPs.

The chair reiterated that he heard some members' desire to discuss how the process for presenting candidates to the Governing Board (By-Law 3) could be improved and committed to adding this topic to the agenda for the next meeting. He emphasized the

importance of focusing on whether the established process was followed and reminded members that their role was to vote solely on the Resolution as it stands.

Recommendation - Director General

WHEREAS on March 15, 2023, the Board of Governors of Champlain Regional College appointed the SelectionCommittee for the selection of a Director General; and

WHEREAS the Selection Committee has fulfilled all of its responsibilities relating to this procedure and has made its recommendation; and

WHEREAS the Chair of the Board of Governors presented the report of the Selection Committee including therecommended candidate's profile to all Commission of Studies and Governing Boards on September 24, 2024; and

WHEREAS each governing body met with their members to discuss the recommendation on September 24, 2024;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Governing Board recommends the candidate for the position of Director General to the Board of Governors.
