APPLICATION FEE

All students who apply for admission or re-admission must pay a \$30.00 application fee. This fee is payable at the time of application and is non-refundable. An additional \$35.00 is required for the English Level Assessment for students who are not coming from a Québec English high school.

FULL-TIME STUDENTS (Canadian citizens and landed immigrants)

A full-time student is one who is enrolled in at least four (4) courses or (180 hours of class) per semester.
